# Registration

- Complete the registration form at [discovermacs.org/summercamp](http://discovermacs.org/summercamp).
- Completed registration form must be emailed to: [Macscamp@rcdoc.org](mailto:Macscamp@rcdoc.org)
- Once MACS receives your completed form, you will receive an email confirmation reserving your child's spot and a prepay email invite from FACTS tuition management.
- Camps are **NON-REFUNDABLE**, regardless of the reason for cancellation. You are responsible for any remaining balances.
- Camps are filled on a first come first serve basis. Registration will close when camp is full.
- Payments can be made at [ONLINE.FACTSMGT.COM](http://ONLINE.FACTSMGT.COM)
- Register by week. You can pick the weeks that work best for you and your campers summer schedule.

All transportation is provided by MACS bus drivers.

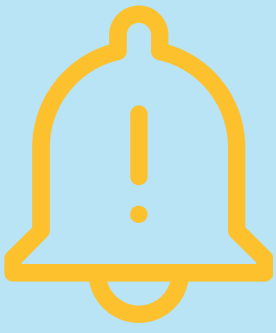
## Dress For Mess:

## Newsletter, Schedule

A camp newsletter with additional information for the week will be provided on Monday's. No other correspondence will be sent prior.

## Philosophy

The Philosophy of all MACS programs is to love your neighbor as yourself by providing mutual respect for all staff and campers. We realize that children are learning this principle as they grow, however, camp expectations and consequences will be made known to campers upon their first day of camp. Should a discipline problem arise,

the child will be spoken to in hopes that through discussion and redirection, the problem will be corrected.

If this does not solve the problem, a time out will be given. Should the problem continue, the parent/guardian will be notified so that the problem may be discussed. A meeting with the director, parent/guardian, and child will follow. If these steps prove unsuccessful, the child may be dismissed from the camp with no refund.

## Camp Shirts

## & Tote Bags

Camp shirts and bags will be issued on your child's first day of camp. T-shirts are designed for safety by allowing camp staff to easily identify the MACS summer campers. It is **REQUIRED** that all children wear their camp shirts on field trip days.

# IMPORTANT INFO

**Drop Off & Pick-up**  
Staff must be notified in writing if someone other than the authorized persons on the registration form will be picking up your child. No child will be allowed to walk home, wait by themselves or leave with a minor sibling.

## Late Pick Up

A late pick up fee of \$10 will be charged from 5:01-5:05. After 5:05, \$1/minute will be charged. If a child has not been picked up by 5:15 and a parent cannot be reached, your emergency contact will be called. If a child is left after 5:00pm, three times, attendance at camp may be denied with no refund.

## Accommodations & Special Diets

If your child requires any special assistance, please discuss with the Summer Camp Coordinator for prior approval before registering for camp. Children on special diets or with any type of food allergy will need to bring their own snacks and lunch on Friday's. Please include information concerning any allergies on the registration form.

## Medication & Tummy Aches

If your child is required to have medications, a medical form will be required to be completed prior to the start of camp. You may request forms in advance. Medication should be administered from the original container and must be labeled with your child's name, name of medication, physician and times to be given. Please **DO NOT** send your child to camp sick!!!

## Cancellations

Please choose your weeks carefully. In the event of cancellation, all deposits and fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**, regardless of the reason. Please remember as you plan your summer that camp, staffing, supplies, and schedules are based on weekly registration.

- After receiving a prepay invite email from FACTS Tuition Management, submit payment for the following to reserve a spot:
  1. A One Time \$85 **NON-REFUNDABLE** registration fee per summer
  2. \$200 deposit, per week, per child
- The remaining camp balances must be paid **IN FULL** by **MAY 17TH**. You will **NOT** receive a reminder!

- Additions and transfers are based upon a space available basis
